We are challenging you to show us what you know about staying safe when you're out and about!

Go out, with an adult, and find the places in our list. Get a photograph of as many of them as you can find, making sure that each photo is taken from your eye level.

In each place, have a think about what could go wrong and what you should do to make sure that you stay safe.

You might have to think about whether it would be a good place to choose to cross the road, what you would need to do to cross there safely or whether there is something better and safer you could do instead.

The Challenge

Can you find:

- 1. A place where traffic can come from 3 directions?
- 2. A place where traffic can come from 4 directions?
- 3. A pedestrian crossing?
- 4. A line of parked cars?
- 5. A place where something is stopping you from seeing if any traffic is coming?
- 6. A place where a driver wouldn't be able to see you waiting to cross the road?



Here's an example: Can you find a place where the pavement meets the road?



What could go wrong here?

If I walk from the pavement into the road without stopping and looking, there could be a Car Coming and I could get hurt.

What should you do?

Stop at the kerb. Never go onto the road until I have made sure that there is no traffic coming.
